## HOW TO ACCESS YOUR DEGREE PROGRESS REPORT (DPR)

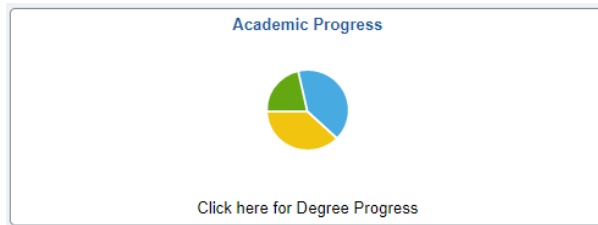
The Degree Progress Report in your Student Center lets you see how coursework applies toward your degree, what requirements are still needed, and the choices you have to satisfy each requirement.

1. Log into your Student Center at <https://www.maricopa.edu/students>

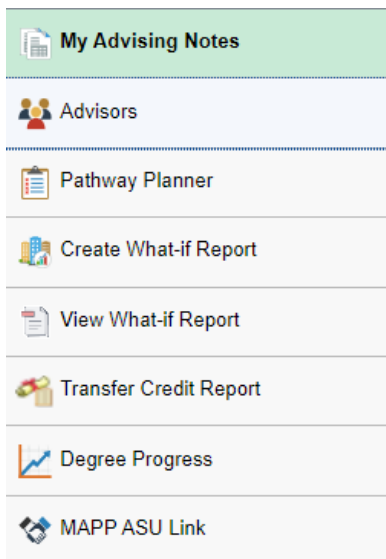

2. Click the "Academic Progress" tile.



3. On the left side, select "Degree Progress"



4. A report will run based on your current program on file and will show any transfer credits on file, the courses that applied to this program, courses that do not apply, and what you still need to complete.

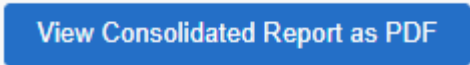
5. For any "Not Satisfied" areas, you can click into them to see all of the options for courses that will apply.
