

## New Student Enrollment Steps

**1. Apply for your GI Bill® benefits online** through VA.gov, if you have not already done so <https://www.va.gov/> Click apply for Education Benefits and follow the instructions.  
(Please make sure that your election Start Date is at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the semester. See [Academic Calendar](#) )

### **2. Create MEID Account and Apply for Admissions**

Online: <https://admissions.maricopa.edu/> click on “Start Here!” and follow the directions

In Person: Complete the Student Admission Application form.

- Provide proof of identity to the college
- For tuition purposes, verify your residency status by providing a government issued ID.

**3. Activate your Maricopa email** by entering your MEID and password at [google.maricopa.edu](http://google.maricopa.edu)

\*All college communications **must** come through your official student email account.

**4. Apply for financial aid** (Recommended not required) Apply at <https://fafsa.ed.gov/>

**5. Order official military and academic transcripts** from ALL colleges previously attended to include CLEP and Dantes (required by Department of Veteran Affairs). Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard veterans can access transcripts at: <https://jst.doded.mil> Air Force veterans, CCAF transcript request form is available at the Veterans Center. \*Transcript must be mailed directly to:

**6. Take the on-campus placement tests or if you graduated High School in the last 10 years show your High School transcripts to testing services.**

Required for new students. Transferring students see advisor before testing. Additional information at:

**7. Meet with the EMCC Veterans Academic Advisor** to identify a degree plan and assess your individual needs.

\*Bring any transcripts (even unofficial) and questions.

**8. Attend the Required Orientation Advisement and Registration (ROAR)** This session will be your advisement and orientation to help you prepare for your first semester of classes. Be sure to bring:

- Your placement scores
- Unofficial Transcripts
- Student ID number

**9. Enroll in classes then Request for Benefits in the EMCC Veterans Center**  
**\*\*\*EVERY TERM as early as possible**

**DD214, COE, Unofficial Transcripts**

**10. Attend a Mandatory Veterans Benefits Orientation (VBO).** Required Attendance of Veterans and Dependents using VA Education Benefits.

**Learning starts day one.** Students who do not show up for the first class will be dropped unless prior arrangements with the instructor are made.
