



# EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM CODES

## AGEC, Degree and Certificate Information

**AGEC - Arizona General Education Curriculum** is a 35 semester credit block of lower division general education courses designed for students transferring to public universities. Certified completion of the block satisfies admission requirements to an Arizona university and will fulfill all lower division general education requirements for the majors with which each block articulates. There are three AGECE blocks: AGECE-A, intended for liberal arts and other majors; AGECE-B, intended for business majors; and AGECE-S, intended for majors with more stringent mathematics and mathematics-based science requirements.

**AA - Associate in Arts Degree** includes AGECE-A and transfers as a block without loss of credit to Arizona's public universities. In general, the components of the degree meet requirements for majors in the Liberal Arts or programs of study other than business or science.

**AAEE - Associate in Arts, Elementary Education Degree** includes AGECE-A and transfers as a block without loss of credit to Arizona's public universities. The AAEE is designed for students who plan to transfer to an Elementary Education program at an Arizona public higher education institution and/or who plan to become a classroom instructional aide.

**AAFA - Associate in Arts, Fine Arts Degree** includes AGECE-A and transfers as a block without loss of credit to Arizona's public universities. In general, the components of the degree meet requirements for majors in the Fine Arts. Specializations in Art, Dance, and Theatre are available.

**AS - Associate in Science Degree** includes AGECE-S and transfers as a block without loss of credit to Arizona's public universities. In general, the components of the AS degree meet requirements for majors with more stringent mathematics and mathematics-based science requirements.

**ABUS - Associate in Business Degree** includes AGECE-B. The ABus GR degree is designed for students who plan to transfer to Arizona's public universities into majors that articulate with the Associate in Business General Requirements (ABus-GR) pathway. All business majors except Accountancy and Computer Information Systems should follow the **ABus-GR** pathway. Accountancy majors should follow the **TG-XR** pathway. Computer Information Systems majors should follow the **ABus-SR** pathway.

**ATP - Associate in Transfer Partnership Degree** is designed to meet the needs of Maricopa Community College students transferring to public and private universities. This degree is developed specifically for students who have an identified major and have selected the baccalaureate degree-granting institution to which they intend to transfer.

**AGS - Associate in General Studies Degree** is designed for students whose educational goals require flexibility OR who choose to take courses which may later apply toward a degree.

**AAS - Associate in Applied Science Degree** is designed for students who wish to gain a depth of technical expertise in a specified career area.

**AC - Academic Certificate** is a defined and coherent program of study that is recommended for students who wish to gain additional expertise in an academic area. While this program of study can result in proficiency in specified skills and competencies, as well as mastery of knowledge, it is not designed to prepare someone for employment in a specific occupation.

**CCL - Certificate of Completion** is designed for students who plan to complete an occupational program requiring fewer credit units than a degree.
