STEP 2.The The college DE Coordinator will provide the DE high school instructor instruction (written process) to the DE high school instructors. The high school instructor will self-enroll using the URL:

STEP 3. The DE high school instructor will enroll in the DE course, complete the module and quizzes. After the quizzes, the instructor will click the grades button in the navigation menu and print out a copy of their grade. DE high school instructors must earn a minimum of 80% on the module quizzes.
The course must be completed by the end of the first semester of teaching a Dual Enrollment Course.
STEP 4.The high school DE instructor will submit the grade printout to the college DE Coordinator to verify completion of the course.
STEP 5.The DE Coordinator will file the copy of the grade sheet in the DE high school instructor's file.
STEP 6. The District Office Director of DE will notify the college DE Coordinators when the DE Module will be updated. The DO Director will be contacted for questions regarding enrollment of DE High School instructors.
