Our system needs to be set up to support residential faculty to offer these programs.

- Enrollment Logistics This was previously offered to colleges and had logistics challenges enrolling students into sections.
- For credit is not an option for now. Noncredit is an option.
- Challenge to offer credit training by residential faculty.
- How will students register?
- What's the commitment of the residential faculty?
- Workforce Development has done this through MCOR-offered EDE 500 community education classes.

Q: Does each College need to commit to a number of licenses? Or collectively as a district?

A: We request collectively as a district and support those interested colleges.

• Licenses are active through 2024.

Q: How does the instructor get paid? Is this for credit? There is an impact on credit load hours.
