Diversity of Enrollment

In Fall 2022 enrollment of all full-time undergraduate students in credit programs was 2421 .Of these 60% were female and 40% were male. 1% were American Indian/Alaska Native, 4% were Asian/Pacific Islander, 6% were Black, 60% were Hispanic, 23% were White, 5% were Two or More Races, and 1% were Non-Resident Alien.

Diversity of Pell Recipients

Federal Pell Grant recipients comprised 40% of the full-time enrolled students in Fall 2022. Of these, 65% were female and 35% were male. 83% of the Pell recipients identified themselves as members of a racial or ethnic minority.

Retention Rates

71.75% of the first-time, full-time undergraduate students who enrolled in Fall 2021 returned in Fall 2022. The part-time student retention rate was 48.21%.

Graduation and Transfer Rates

The 3-year graduation rate for full-time students entering in Fall 2019 was 18%. The 3-year transfer-out rate was 15%
