

Maricopa County Community Colleges District Certificate of Insurance Requirements

Before a purchase order is released or a contract signed, vendors/contractors doing business with MCCCD/Estrella Mountain Community College for services are required to provide a certificate of insurance (COI)

The certificate must contain the following:

Fiscal Services

• MCCCD named as certificate holder. The Certificate Holder can read Maricopa County Community College District. The legal name of MCCCD must be listed first and can be followed with the college name and contact:

Maricopa County Community College District Estrella Mountain Community College 3000 N. Dysart Rd Avondale, AZ 85392

MCCCD named as an additional insured: Maricopa County Community College District, its agents, officers, officials, employees, and volunteers are hereby named as additional insureds as their interests may appear.

30-day cancellation notice

The certificate must also include, at a minimum, the following insurance coverage:

- Commercial General Liability (GL) = Each Occurrence \$1,000,000 and General Aggregate \$2,000,000
- Commercial Automobile Liability (AL) = \$1,000,000
- Workers' Compensation (WC) = \$1,000,000

Certain vendors or contractors may be exempt from providing proof of Workers' Compensation insurance. In which case a Sole Proprietor Waiver or an Independent Contractor Agreement should be completed. **If so, a letter attesting to the exemption must accompany the certificate.**

Other types of coverage and limits may be required in your contract, depending upon the exposures.
