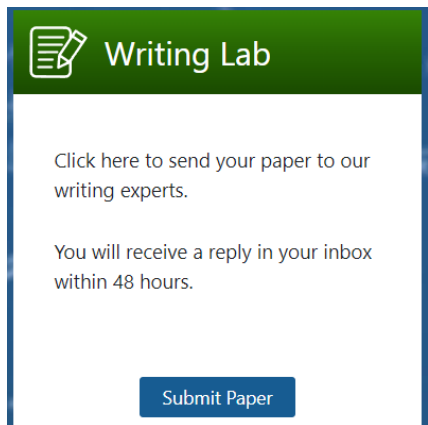


Students – There are two ways to access the EMCC ONLINE WRITING CENTER. Papers will need to be in one of the following formats when submitted: Word (.doc, .docx); PowerPoint (.ppt, .pptx); or Rich Text (.rtf).

1. Visit [tutoring.estrellamountain.edu](http://tutoring.estrellamountain.edu) and log in with your MEID and password.
2. Visit [estrellamountain.edu/students](http://estrellamountain.edu/students) and click Online Writing Center. Then log in with your MEID and password.

Once you have logged in, you will see Writing Lab on the right side of the webpage. Click Submit Paper.



On the next screen, provide the assignment details, add comments if needed, and attach your paper. Assignment details help the tutors provide a thorough review! \*Steps 1-3 are provided below for illustrative purposes. Continue filling out the form through step 11.

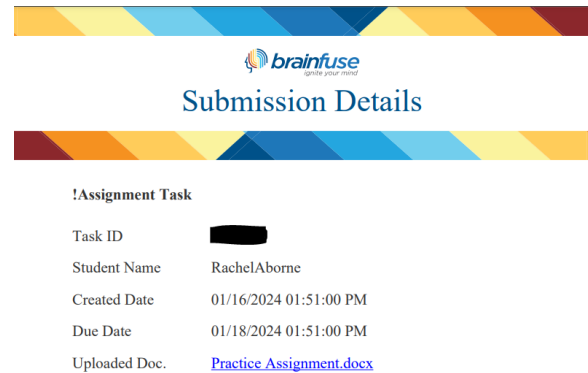

Once your paper is submitted, you will have the option to download a receipt.

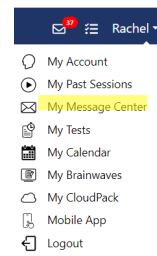
