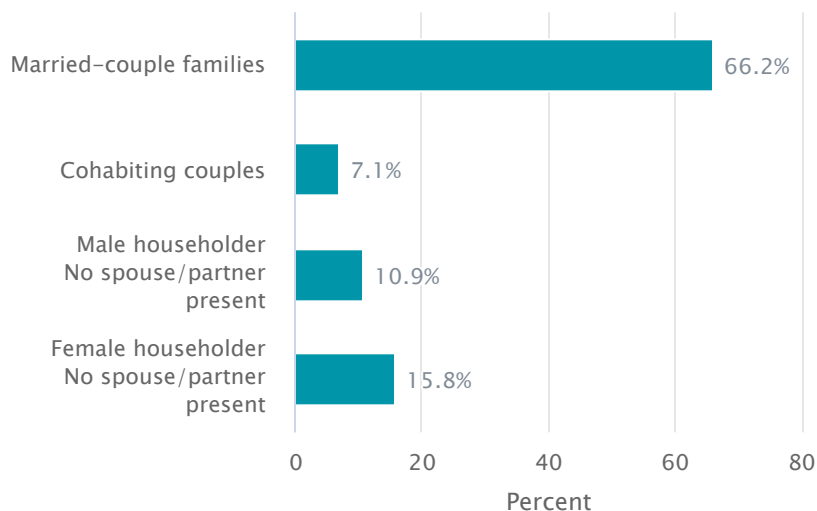
Households and Families

In 2015-2019, there were 18,875 households in Buckeye city, Arizona. The average household size was 3.36 people.

Married-couple households made up 66.2 percent of the households in Buckeye city, Arizona while cohabiting couple households made up 7.1 percent of households. Female householder families with no spouse or partner present and own children under 18 years were 4.2 percent of all households, while 1.2 percent of households were male householder families with no spouse or partner present and own children under 18 years. Of people living alone, 6.8 percent were male householders, and 6.4 percent were female householders, for a total of 13.2 percent of all households.

In Buckeye city, Arizona, 49.0 percent of all households have one or more people under the age of 18; 27.8 percent of all households have one or more people 65 years and over.

Marital status

Among persons 15 and older, 48.4 percent of males and 55.5 percent of females are currently married.

Grandparents and grandchildren

In Buckeye city, Arizona, 2,339 grandparents lived with their grandchildren under 18 years old. Of those grandparents, 37.0 percent were responsible for the basic needs of their grandchildren.

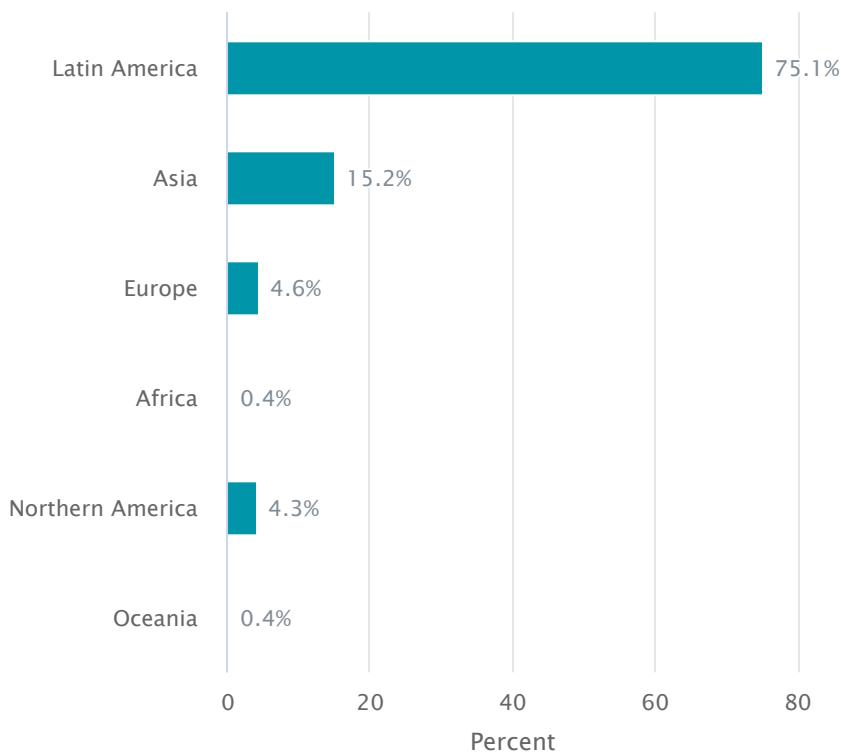
Nativity and Foreign Born

In 2015-2019, an estimated 89.6 percent of the people living in Buckeye city, Arizona were U.S. natives. 37.4 percent of the Buckeye city, Arizona population were living in the state where they were born.

Approximately 10.4 percent of Buckeye city, Arizona residents in 2015-2019 were foreign-born. 49.3 percent of foreign born were naturalized U.S. citizens and an estimated 86.0 percent entered the country before the year 2010.

Foreign-born residents of Buckeye city, Arizona come from different parts of the world. The bar graph below displays the percentage of foreign born from each world region of birth in 2015-2019 for Buckeye city, Arizona.

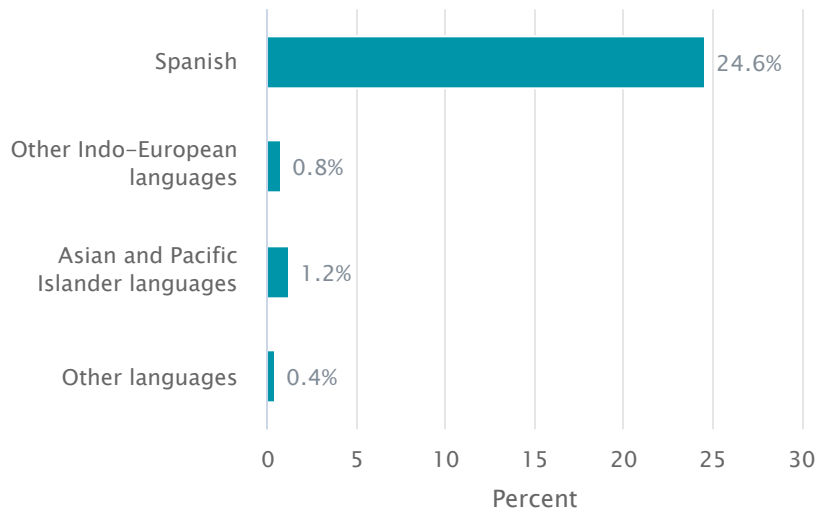
Region of Birth for the Foreign-Born Population in Buckeye city, Arizona in 2015-2019



Language

Among people at least five years old living in Buckeye city, Arizona in 2015-2019, 27.0 percent spoke a language other than English at home. Spanish was spoken by 24.6 percent of people at least five years old; 7.9 percent reported that they did not speak English "very well."

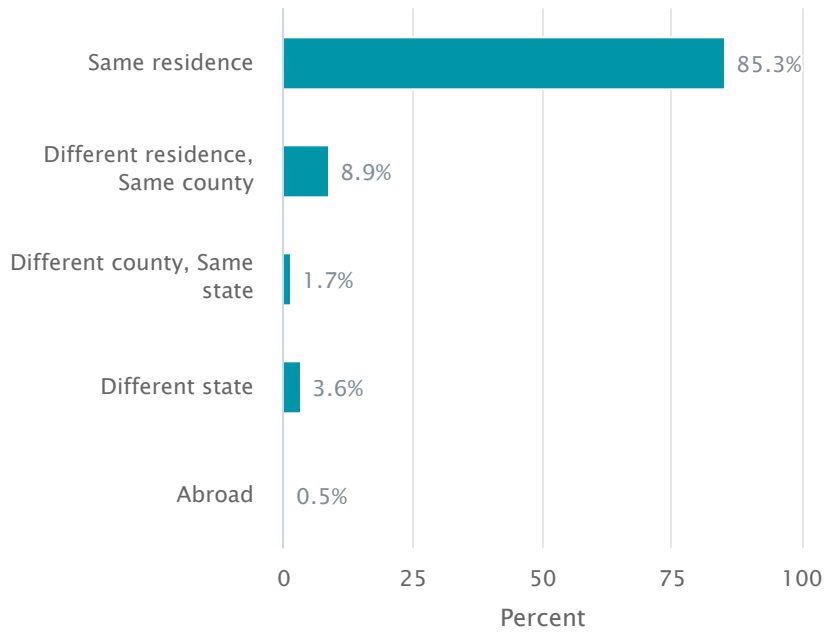
Percent of the Population 5 years and over who Speak a Language other than English in Buckeye city, Arizona in 2015-2019



Geographic Mobility

In 2015-2019, 85.3 percent of the people at least one year old living in Buckeye city, Arizona were living in the same residence one year earlier.

Geographic Mobility of Residents of Buckeye city, Arizona in 2015-2019

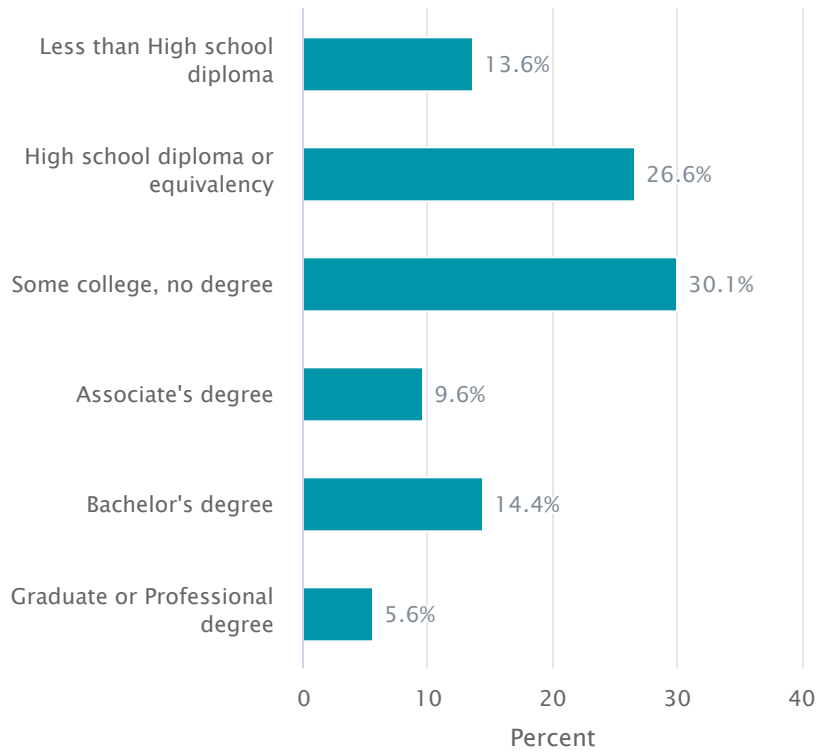


Education

In 2015-2019, 86.4 percent of people 25 years and over had at least graduated from high school and 20.0 percent had a bachelor's degree or higher. An estimated 13.6 percent did not complete high school.

The total school enrollment in Buckeye city, Arizona was 19,371 in 2015-2019. Nursery school enrollment was 772 and kindergarten through 12th grade enrollment was 14,953. College or graduate school enrollment was 3,646.

Disability

In Buckeye city, Arizona, among the civilian noninstitutionalized population in 2015-2019, 11.2 percent reported a disability. The likelihood of having a disability varied by age - from 5.4 percent of people under 18 years old, to 10.1 percent of people 18 to 64 years old, and to 29.7 percent of those 65 and over.

Employment Status and Type of Employer

In Buckeye city, Arizona, 52.3 percent of the population 16 and over were employed; 44.0 percent were not currently in the labor force.

An estimated 80.4 percent of the people employed were private wage and salary workers; 16.0 percent were federal, state, or local government workers; and 3.5 percent were self-employed in their own (not incorporated) business.
