What does EMCC Recycle?

Recycling containers are located throughout the campus and are marked with the recycle symbol

-  **Paper**
paper, junk mail, newspapers, magazines, books, colored paper, post-it notes, etc.
-  **Plastic**
plastic containers and bottles, plastic
-  **Glass**
glass bottles and jars
-  **Aluminum**
metal cans, aluminum cans, foil

NO Trash, **NO** Liquids, **NO** Styrofoam, **NO** Food or Yard Waste,
NO Paint or Chemicals, **NO** Plastic Bags

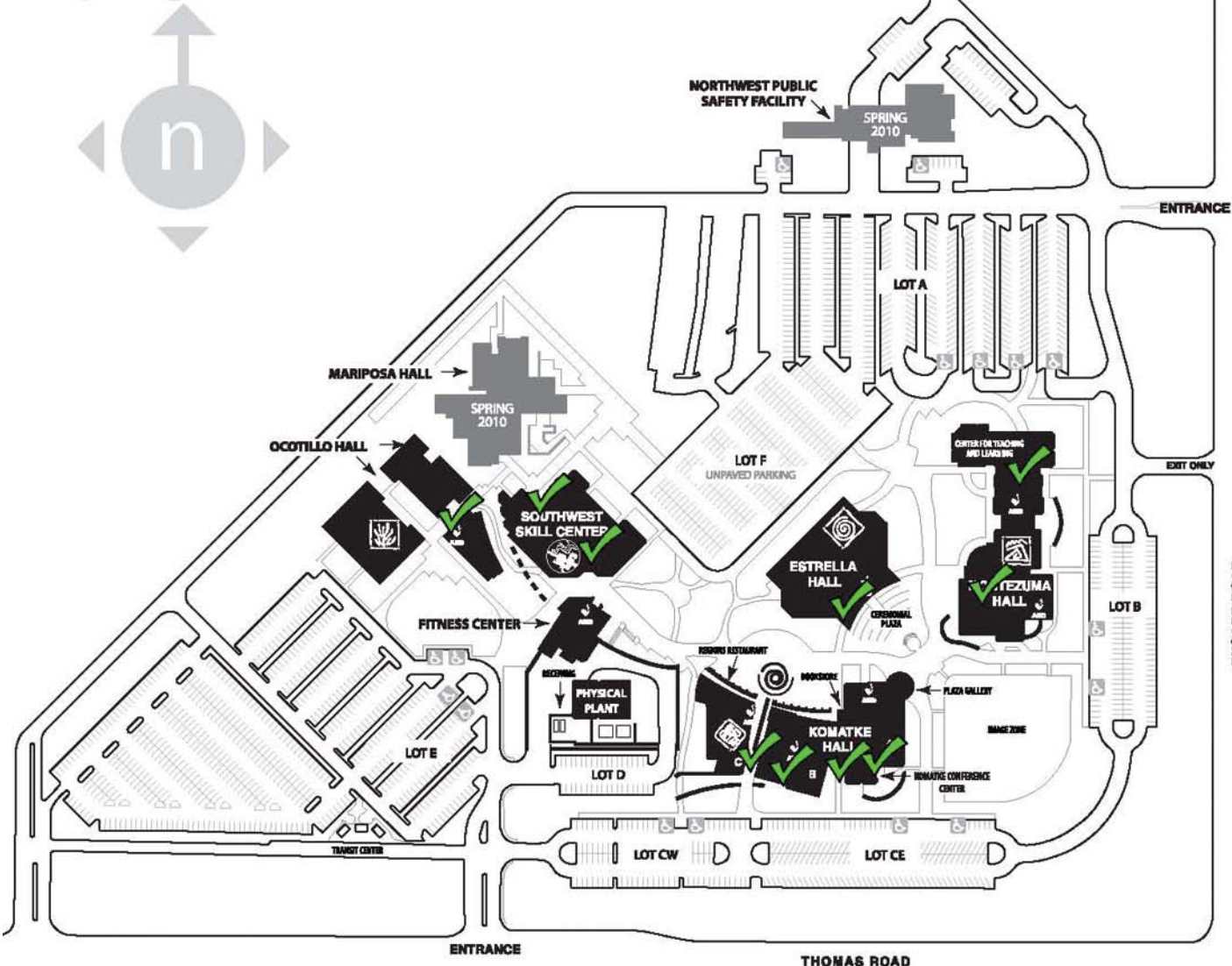


Green Lions R-R-R-Recycling

Recycling Bin Locations



Recycling Information | FAQ's

Items that can be recycled in the co-mingled (mixed recyclables) containers: plastic, glass, paper, and aluminum

Cardboard to be broken down and placed next to containers

Shredded paper to be put in a bag and placed next to the container

Items that are not permitted: trash, liquid, styrofoam, plastic bags, electronics, food/yard waste, paint/chemicals

Individual recycling containers will not be picked up by facilities, please empty these into the large recycling containers (see map)

Recycling bins can be placed in classrooms if a faculty/staff volunteers to be responsible for emptying the bins

Containers may be unavailable between 2:00pm on Wednesday and 7:00am on Thursday each week for weekly Avondale Recycling pickup
