

Nursing Pathways at EMCC





Traditional (non-CEP)



Potential applicants are encouraged to meet with Health Sciences advisors each semester while working on their nursing prerequisites and then with the nursing advisor when they are ready to submit their traditional nursing application.



There is approximately a two to two and half year waiting period from the time a student submits their traditional nursing application to when they are accepted.





After completion of the AAS in nursing, students are eligible to take the NCLEX-RN to become licensed as a Registered Nurse (RN).

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
Nursing Assistant

Successful completion of a nurse assistant course (NCE150 or NUR158) or

current active AZ certification or licensure as a Nurse Assistant in good standing is required to complete the traditional nursing application.

When a traditional application is submitted the following will need to be included.

Unofficial high school transcript: All MaricopaNursing programs require a high school diploma or GED.



HESI Assessment HESI A2: All applicants must score 80% or higher in the English language composite score and 75% or higher in math within 24 months of application.



Arizona Department of Public Safety Level One Fingerprint Clearance Card.



Unofficial copy of all transcripts used to meet prerequisites, including high school transcripts, should be included with the application.

Potential applicants are encouraged to meet with the nursing advisor each semester while working on their co-requisites and then again when they are ready to submit their CEP nursing application.



This pathway does not have a waiting period, but it is <u>competitive</u> and applications are only taken twice a year. Application cycles are generally between December 1 to January 31 and April 1 to May 31. 222 Applications should be submitted at the college of first choice. This information can also be found on the MaricopaNursing website.



Upon successful completion of the CEP nursing program pathway, students will be awarded an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in nursing from a Maricopa school and a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) from a university partner.

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After completion of this pathway, student are eligible to take the NCLEX-RN to become licensed as a Registered Nurse (RN). ESTRELLA MOUNTAIN

When a CEP application is submitted the following will need to be included.

Traditional nursing application, if it has not already been submitted previously.



The CEP application with a signed copy of the information session declaration.



Arizona Department of Public Safety Level One Fingerprint Clearance Card.



Unofficial copy of all transcripts used to meet prerequisites, including high school transcripts, should be included with the application.



HESI Assessment HESI A2: All applicants must score 80% or higher in the English language composite score and 75% or higher in math within 24 months of application.






MaricopaNursing partners with five universities for the CEP program. ASU, GCU, NAU, Ottawa, and Upper Iowa.


Each university partner has different requirements, students should be sure to read all the brochures and watch the CEP information session to find the right university for them.

Also, students should contact an advisor at the university partner of their choice to ask specific questions.




HESI A2
