Mission: Increase the number of underrepresented female students choosing to go to college by inspiring them to pursue an engineering and science education and envision future careers in a technical field.

Our Cause: Many young Latina girls don't know what opportunities are available in technology, or what it takes to be an engineer, scientist or a technical professional. They don't even realize it is an option. All too often, there is the perception that these professions are not considered "traditional careers" for Latinas - as reflected by the low number of Latinas that major in the technical fields. This is the segment of our increasingly growing population in Arizona that is most at risk of not being prepared to enter the workforce of the future.

Intel Corporation is collaborating with the Maricopa Community College District to sponsor this pre-college conference. Our target audience is Latina girls, grades 6 – 12.

We have a dynamic planning committee comprised of representatives from Intel, IBM and Estrella Mountain Community College. We hope that this model serves as a starting point to increase the partnerships between various academic institutions and Corporate America with the common goal of increasing college enrollment and graduation rates in the science and engineering fields.

Program:

- **Welcome and Breakfast** – students will be welcomed to the campus and introduced to the events for the day
- **Hands-on Workshops** - The workshops are comprised of fun, interactive, hands-on math and science focused activities to introduce concepts in problem-solving, teamwork and creativity.
- **Latina Town Hall** – Participants will have the opportunity to meet and speak with successful Latina professionals and learn what they did not get to where they are today. We will also have Hermanas graduates talk about what they did in high school to get to where they are today!
- **Education Overview** - Presenters will discuss with participants what they need to do in high school to prepare for college. Students want to make sure they are doing everything they can to prepare to apply to and get into college.
- **Closing Ceremony** – Participants will be able to reflect on what they learned and enter to win a lap top computer!
