

Ruffalo Noel-Levitz Student Satisfaction Inventory (SSI) EMCC Spring 2022 Summary Results

Purpose and Background

The purpose of the Ruffalo Noel-Levitz Student Satisfaction Inventory (SSI) is to evaluate a college's academic, instructional, and student support services from the student perspective. Estrella Mountain's most recent SSI administration occurred during spring 2022. EMCC Student Satisfaction Inventory results offer opportunities for improving services provided to students.

The Ruffalo Noel-Levitz survey instrument provides a dual rating system, (using a 7-point Likert scale) to measure the perceived importance and relative satisfaction with student services and programs. Survey results present performance gap analysis and national satisfaction mean comparisons. Performance gap analysis measures the mean difference between importance ratings and satisfaction ratings. Comparison data also provides Estrella Mountain student ratings to a national norm for community and 2-year colleges.

Items indicating both <u>high levels of importance</u> and <u>high levels of satisfaction</u> listed as strengths in order of importance. Individual items by scale categories:

Academic Services

- ➤ Computer labs are adequate and accessible.
- > Tutoring services are readily available.
- > There are a sufficient number of study areas on campus.
- ➤ Library staff are helpful and approachable.

Campus Climate

- > Students are made to feel welcome on this campus.
- ➤ People on this campus respect and are supportive of each other
- ➤ The campus staff are caring and helpful

Instructional Effectiveness

- ➤ I am able to experience intellectual growth here.
- > There is a good variety of courses provided on this campus.

Not on Scale

➤ On the whole, the campus is well-maintained.

Registration Effectiveness

- > There are convenient ways of paying my school bill.
- ➤ Class change (drop/add)policies are reasonable
- ➤ Bookstore staff are helpful

Safety and Security

- > The campus is safe and secure for all students.
- ➤ Parking lots are well-lighted and secure
