

HOW TO APPLY FOR GRADUATION

For all Associate degrees, you need a minimum of 60 credits and 15 should be from here at EMCC. For all Certificate programs, you should have at least 6 credits here at EMCC.

You can check your progress by using the Degree Progress Report on your Student Center:

- Log in to https://my.maricopa.edu with your MEID and password
- Select the "Academic Progress" tile
- Choose "Degree Progress" from the navigation menu on the left
- Your program plan must be correct for this tool to work you can check this from the "View Current
 Admissions" tile. If your current plan is incorrect, you will need to update that before you can apply.

Once you believe that you are ready to apply for graduation and all requirements are met, you will meet with your advisor to complete your application for graduation.

** Pro-tip: You can also complete this process much faster via email

Make an appointment with your advisor or email them to request completion of your graduation application.

You will fill out "Student Information" on the top of the graduation application here - https://bit.ly/EMCGradApp and sign and date the bottom.

Submit the completed graduation application **and** the graduation survey confirmation page to your advisor for completion. If you update your program plan in order to apply, save a copy of the PDF showing your updates and submit that to your advisor as well.

Advisement will review your credits and create/update a check sheet for your program to ensure you meet all requirements. Once that is verified, they will submit all documents to Admissions and Records on your behalf and send you copies of your graduation application and supplemental documentation proving that you are now in applied status.

Please note: EMCC offers *one* commencement ceremony per year in May. All Fall, Spring, and Summer graduates are welcome to participate. In order to guarantee your spot in the program, you will need to submit your application no later than the last Friday in March.

The final deadline for graduation applications is the last date of the semester in which you are graduating.
