### **STO 292: The Art of Storytelling**

Explore the art and origin of storytelling. Provide a variety of storytelling techniques, styles and exercises to enhance the delivery of telling stories. Assist in the integration and application of storytelling to the learning environment in the classroom. *[General Education Designations: (HU) Humanities and Fine Arts; (C) Cultural Diversity]. (Cross-reference courses: EDU292, HUM292).*

### **STO 293: The Art of Storytelling II**

Further exploration of the art of storytelling. Provide opportunities for the expansion of storytelling skills and a deeper appreciation of storytelling and its applications. (Prerequisites: Grade of C or better in EDU292, HUM292, or STO292).

### **STO 294: Multicultural Folktales**

Study of multicultural folktales, exploring the impact of the oral tradition in American society and showing classroom applications. *[General Education Designations: (C) Cultural Diversity; (HU) Humanities and Fine Arts]. (Cross-reference courses: EDU294, ENH294).*
